Stitching Memories

1) Knitting needles

- a. Circular – good for knitting in the round or flat
- b. Straight – can only knit flat (back and forth)
- c. Double pointed needles (dpn's) – used for knitting in the round and making I-cord

2) Yarn

- a. Comes in several forms
- b. Skeins – need to remove the end from the inside of the skein to make it center pull
- c. Balls – usually pull from the outside
- d. Hanks – need to be wound into a center pull ball (aka. Yarn cake)

3) Casting On

- a. Knitted cast-on
- b. Slip knot

4) Knit stitch

5) I-cord Handles

6) Items/notions for knitting bag

- a. Scissors
- b. Tape measure
- c. Tapestry needle (blunt tip, large eye)
- d. Pencil

7) Optional items

- a. Stitch markers
- b. Row counters
- c. Calculator
- d. Crochet hook (for fixing mistakes)
- e. Point protectors
